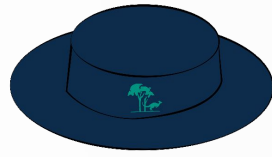

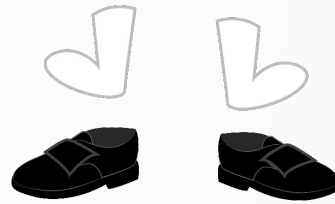
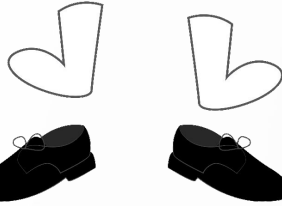

Enrolment

Regular school attendance supports students to be connected, achieve their potential and increase their career and life options (DoE, 2021). Parents are legally responsible to ensure that their children of compulsory school age are enrolled at and attending school. If your child is absent from school, parents are required to provide written reasoning within seven days of their absence by filling out the absence form, or digitally via the RCPS E-News app. All students should be at school before the bell rings at 9:00am. If your child arrives at school after this time, they are required to sign in at the office and collect a Late Pass that is to be handed on to their classroom teacher. If you wish for your child to leave school before the end of the day, it is necessary for the parent/carer to sign them out from the front office. Applications for extended leave are to be approved by the Principal.

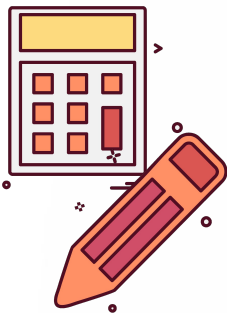
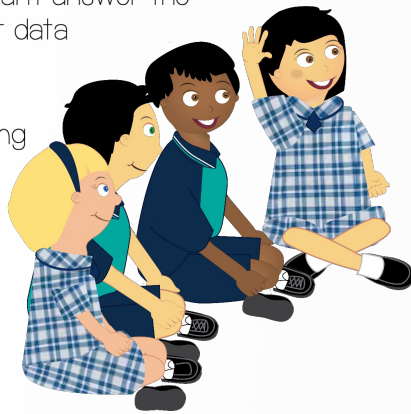

The Best Start Kindergarten Assessment is a state-wide assessment that helps teachers identify the literacy and numeracy skills which your child brings with them at the beginning of Kindergarten. The assessment takes approximately 20 minutes each for the literacy and numeracy components. It is conducted one-on-one by a Kindergarten teacher who will ensure that your child feels at ease and is comfortable. The assessment does not require students to prepare or study, so don't be concerned if your child can't answer the questions. The Best Start data provides teachers with information so that they can plan effective teaching and learning programs.



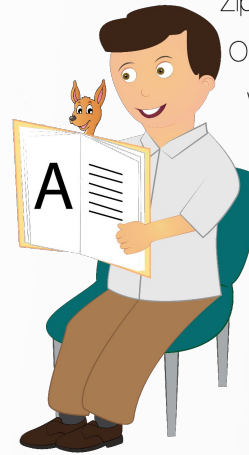

- Social skills 



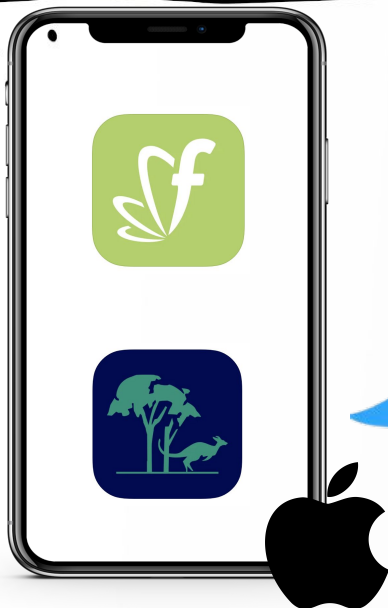

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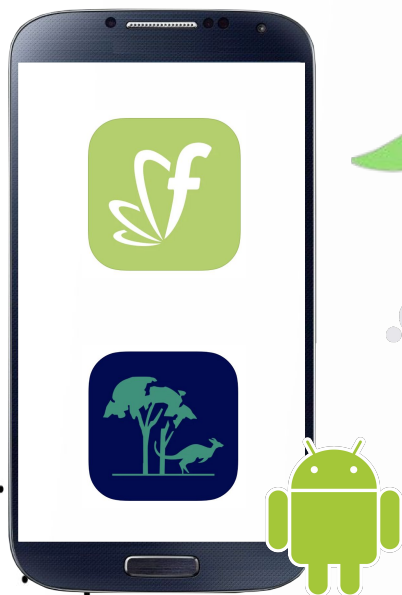

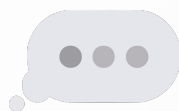
