

In PBL News.....



We have some very exciting changes to our playground. The PBL & Kids Matter teams have been working in collaboration with our students to develop NEW playground zones. These zones have been created to ensure all students have a safe place to play.

The playground has been separated into 6 play spaces. Each playground space has its own colour (blue, green, pink, purple, yellow and orange). In the morning, we refer to our playground as the white zone. The white zone is a calm, walking zone that we all share together. Every zone has its own equipment that is clearly labelled, signage to indicate the areas colour zone and our teachers are wearing coloured lanyards to remind students of each areas activities and expectations.

The changes to our playground and the newly introduced colour zones have been clearly explained to all of our students and staff during our week 1 Zoom session.

Over the last week, we have seen our students happily playing along with their peers in our new zones and can see how much they've enjoyed being able to choose a space that meets their individual needs and interests.

As we have access restrictions in place currently, we have included a map of our school with the new playground zones clearly outlined for you to have a look at. If you have a spare moment, ask your children about the new playground zones and find out which area/s they've been enjoying the most.
