



# PBL Fortnightly Focus

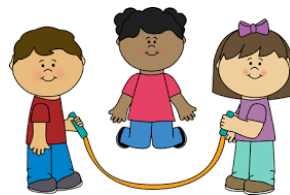


At Ropes Crossing Public School we are **Safe, Responsible, Respectful, Excellent Learners**.

### OUTSIDE the classroom

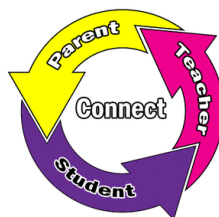
- ✚ Take care of school equipment when playing

- ✚ Put it away carefully and make sure you treat it with respect so that it can be used by others
- ✚ Respect other's equipment, ask for permission before using and always return with a thank-you
